#### **General Information**

- Examinations will be held for Year 11 ATAR
  Courses over a 5 day period from
  Monday 20 November am through to Friday 24
  November am
- Examinations will be held in the examination Room 1.7
- Students are required to be at the examination venue at:
  - > 8.20am for morning examinations
  - > 12.20pm for afternoon examinations
- The practical exam for music will be organised and managed by the classroom teacher.

## **Attendance Requirements**

- Students sitting 3 or more exams will not be required to attend classes during exam week.
- Students sitting 2 or 1 exam will only attend for the period of their exam on the day of the exam but will be required to attend their normal classes for the remainder of exam week.
- Courses being examined will not be delivered on the timetable during exam week.
- Students who have 2 or less exams are expected to attend their normal classes but in the timeslot where they have the course that has been examined should arrange to attend to 'catch up' or task completion.
- Students studying courses that are not being examined are required to attend their normal General Studies / VET program throughout exam week.

## **WACE Conditions**

- Students should bring sufficient writing, erasing, ruling and colouring requirements to cover all their needs. Copying from notes, texts, other students or any other source is not permitted.
- Talking is not permitted from the time you enter until you leave the room. If you have a query, put your hand up and wait for a supervisor.
- Students who are late on arrival for examinations should proceed to the examination room. No compensation for time will be made unless there are extenuating circumstances.
- 4. Leaving the Examination:
  - a. No one leaves in the first hour.
  - b. No one leaves in the last fifteen minutes.
  - Teachers will mark on your paper that you left early and at what time.

These are the same rules as for the WACE external examinations.

- As a further consequence, no student will be admitted after the end of the first hour to any examination.
- Every sheet of answer paper submitted by a student should have the student's name on it. The outer page of all answered material should show the student's name and form group, the subject and class teacher's name.
- As the examinations are part of the normal school program, all students are advised that they are expected to wear full school dress code. Failure to do so may cause exclusion from the examination.
- Please ensure that your mobile telephone is switched off in the exam room and out of your possession e.g. in your school bag.
